you engage in prophecy that that involves descriptive language it starts feeling like Nostradamus like so he

called he called the two towers are gonna fall because he said twin Giants are bound to come down it's like that's

not calling 911 do so there's that aspect there are a few credible dimensions of the Saint Malakai

prophecies but any West friends with Saint Bernard right wasn't yet best fit with those prophecies go back to him no

because the first production of them is like right more recent than the provenance is our art historians say the

provenance is not what you'd like it to be but then so now I'm with you it'll be 7:23

too like robotics people like all the mount st. Malachi prophecy I'm like yeah I'm going to now at that point then

hymns like you hear at the Novus Ordo right but we don't want to go too far in and say that they're off the hook they

definitely seem to be in that camp right I think so yeah and we'll see that also with Malachi Martin here shortly so in 54 on

this Feast of the Assumption Malachi Martin was ordained a priest and it seems from 54 to 58 Malachi Martin was a

10:46

paleontologist doing biblical paleontology at the Pontifical biblical

10:52

Institute I like that I took a biblical paleontology course at Texas A&M when I was doing there's all

10:58

my favorite classes in the four years so I kind of like this he also wrote a book a twovolume that came out in 58 this is

11:05

Malachi Martin the scribal character of the Dead Sea Scrolls so he's come some

kind of a early expert in the Dead Sea Scrolls yes pretty similar to talk on that yeah yeah IQ through the roof

11:18

according to all accounts is naysayers his fanboys everyone says he's a he's a 11:23

he's a swifty he's a real sharpie he's genius yeah yeah genius yeah knows a lot 11:29

of language is a genius simple so from after that he gets kind of famous and he 11:35

gets pulled in to Rome and from 58 to 64 he's the private secretary or some sort 11:43

of private exaggerator or Cardinal baya and by the way Cardinal Bay is a Jesuit 11:48

so you can see the connection the German people think people don't think he's the German because that name is not so

Teutonic succinctly he's a German jazz yeah so and Bayless was I believe 12:03

Cardinal baya was the father confessor to Pius the 12th I think that's correct 12:09

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I'm going off memory on that but I'm pretty sure that baya was that well respected by Pais its wealth so from 58

to 64 that's when Malachi Martin is working for baya this is also obviously 12:24

the time of John the 23rd and the starting of the Second Vatican Council 12:29

when you know and you've talked about it before Tim where we have shadow councils going on documents being drafted what

very squirmy and is allegedly by multiple accounts even because Malachi Martin is so important

13:35

for Fatima has tied himself in with Fatima I should say she's getting squirmy and this even suggesting wacky

13:41

things since the new pontificate became underway like getting on the radio waves 13:47

and announcing then in early early 1960 she's saying I'd like to do this 13:54

before this pontificate gets underway cuz she knew what was happening here this is little she wanted to start a

14:00

podcast right wanted to be on this pod yes you too she's a serious she'd heard 14:06

she heard that this was coming down the pike right that's right or yeah john 14:12

xxiii regarding the seers you've said called improper office of doom prophets 14:17

night in our Fatima videos 60 or 59 when john xxiii opens the letters and I think 14:49

we just certainly determined it was actually in 59 and that correct yeah well there are two accounts of it and it

is the most one more popular count is 59 is when he opened it right after he 15:00

announced the convocation of the council and allegedly Cardinal baya was there for the opening and for the translation

15:08

and this is the famous incidence what makes Malachi Martin so famous in 15:15

Affleck circles it's this claim whether it's true or not the either he was in 15:21

the room or he was in the hallway his bedroom was nearby he overheard what was 15:28

read in the Third Secret of fátima on that fateful day in 1959 when john xxiii said 15:34

allegedly this is not this is not for my pontificate but not for my pontiff you 15:40

yeah which is a weird thing to overhear I mean if it's this secret the your 15:45

legacy my cappuccinos and like you're talking like back back out into the hallway yeah exactly

15:52

exactly that's what I'm saying what do you mean anything that the interesting thing is he'll never specify whether

15:58

he's bringing cappuccinos or whether it was bagels or a little frittata or what all right and and even when you go

listen to the art bell interviews he kind of asked some about it and one of them he's like okay so you you overheard

Martin was in the Holy Land and doing some archeology and whatnot he 22:13

becomes associated with Jewish leaders rabbis both in the Holy Land and in Rome 22:19

and Italy such as Rapp Rabbi Abraham Heschel the 19th century 11962 22:26

and because of this Pope Paul the six in January of 1964 chooses Malachi Martin 22:34

to be one of his guides or companions for his pilgrimage to the Holy Land in 22:40

very well known place with lots of lots of big names coming out of loo bein in the 19th and 20th century I don't know

if we mention that I always forget that fact another fact about him I always forget is that for seven years or

something non-negligible this was not a one-year editorship where he got in arguments and then left

24:52

for seven years better part of a decade he was the religious editor at National 24:59

Review that's right that's in the 70s yeah anyway later in the so yeah okay I forgot it was that 70 to 78 we'll hit it

25:06

yep we'll hit it yeah but that's also very important he has a lot of connections in / important you know New

25:12

York after this period but after the Holy Land incident he in this January 25:20

1964 later in 64 it seems that maybe in

25:25

the first part of the year there is a scandal in which Robert Blair Kaiser who 25:33

had been an ex Jesuit he had been a Jesuit for nine years left was laya 25:39

sized got married to a woman named Susan who Malachi Martin refers to as SU other 25:45

people right refer to her sue and allegedly has an affair with sue Kaiser 25:51

the wife of the ex Jesuit now Robert Blair Kaiser this is the ex Jesuit 25:57

husband he was Time Magazine's correspondent in Rome so this is Vatican 26:05

two but I could do still going on and he's a Jesuit he knows the main Jesuits 26:11

like John Courtney Marie baya Malachi Martin and he's hanging out with them 26:16

and they're going to dinner parties and hanging out we know this from John Courtney Marie we've only been married three years Robert Blair Kaiser accuses 26:25

Malachi Martin of having an affair she is pregnant and I couldn't find anywhere 26:31

in any of the literature if there's any accusation that the baby was Malachi's or if it was Roberts but she was

pregnant when this sexual scandal came

26:42

out there was never an accusation by him there's a documentary on Netflix and 26:48

I've watched it I think three times and he features prominently and he keeps 26:54

getting interviewed Robert Kaiser okay and he never ever met as many as often 27:00

and it's been a horrible marriage and his response to her was so you're going to marry Malachi Martin who was also

the letter right what this is the letter from John Courtney Marie no this is I think the letter from father William

liberty decree that is yeah yeah by and large and he wrote a letter to Robert 28:39

Kaiser in July 1964 so this is pretty

shortly after and in which he says I'm really sorry that this happened that Malachi 28:51

Martin did this to your wife did this to your marriage so father John Courtney Murray's a pretty famous guy is acknowledging that

an affair happened and that Malachi Martin was guilty of it it's not it's not allegedly it's affirmed in that

letter again we have that letter state of July 10th 1964 yeah it's good good 29:12

avid documentary evidence I mean it's still not a smoking gun because Robert 29:17

Kaiser theoretically could have just lied to John Koerner and Robert Kaiser did defenders of Malachi Martin say look

29:24

Robert Kaiser did check into a sanitarium and had major mental issues and so he was just hallucinating

29:31

paranoia he made up this this affair in his own mental instability that's there

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29:38

right but it as I looked into and I see that there's two other sources that are

speaking of it father John Courtney Marie in his letter speaks of Malachi Martin leaving the

29:52

Jesuit and this is the exact phrase I pulled it he speaks of Malachi Martin's apostasy from the society on June 27th

1964 so Marie who had looked into it he

says apostasy from the Society of Jesus tonight

30:11

it's either way it's not expression but it's more like a dishonorable discharge than it is an honorable discharge right

but but of course what Martin would maintain all's life is he left the

Jesuits he was dispensed from two of his three vows but he never left the 30:30

priesthood and even says this is this always John liable who said he was secretly made a bishop so right he
